

SOUTHLAND NATIONAL INSURANCE CORPORATION

NOTICE OF LIQUIDATION

The Superior Court of Wake County, North Carolina ordered Southland National Insurance Corporation ("SNIC") into liquidation on May 2, 2023 ("Order of Liquidation"). The Order of Liquidation found and concluded that SNIC was insolvent, should be liquidated, terminated the rehabilitation proceeding that was then pending against SNIC, and appointed the North Carolina Insurance Commissioner and his successors in office as liquidator of SNIC ("Liquidator"). The Liquidation Court directed the Liquidator to take possession of the assets of SNIC and to administer them under the Liquidation Court's supervision. The Liquidator is vested by operation of law with title to all of the property, contracts, and rights of action of SNIC, wherever located.

The Order of Liquidation enjoins all persons from instituting or prosecuting any suit or other action against the Liquidator, SNIC, or SNIC's property or assets, in accordance with the automatic, nondiscretionary statutory prohibition in N.C.G.S. § 58-30-130.

This notice is for your informational purposes only. It is not notice of a claim against the Southland National Insurance Corporation liquidation estate.
