**VOLUNTARY SETTLEMENT  
AGREEMENT**

**NOW COME**, Shontazz Fuller (hereinafter "Mr. Fuller") and the North Carolina Department of Insurance (hereinafter "Department"), and hereby voluntarily and knowingly enter into the following Voluntary Settlement Agreement (hereinafter "this Agreement"):

**WHEREAS**, the Department has the authority and responsibility for enforcement of insurance laws of this State, and for regulating and licensing bail bondsmen; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 58-71-80(a)(7), the Commissioner may deny, suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew any license under Article 71 of Chapter 58 of the North Carolina General Statutes for failure to comply with or violation of the provisions of Article 71 of Chapter 58 of the North Carolina General Statutes or of any order, rule or regulation of the Commissioner; and

**WHEREAS**, N.C. Gen. Stat. § 58-71-40 (a) and (b) provide that no person shall act in the capacity of a surety bondsman unless qualified and licensed, and the Commissioner may propound any reasonable interrogatories about the applicant's qualifications and any other matters the Commissioner considers necessary to protect the public and ascertain the qualifications of the applicant and conduct a reasonable inquiry or investigation relative to the determination of the applicant's fitness to be licensed or to continue to be licenses; and

**WHEREAS**, N.C. Gen. Stat. § 58-71-80(a) (3) provides that the Commissioner may deny, place on probation, suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew a license for a material misstatement, misrepresentation or fraud in obtaining the license; and

**WHEREAS**, N.C. Gen. Stat. § 58-71-80(a) (6) provides that the Commissioner may deny, place on probation, suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew a license for a conviction of a crime involving dishonesty, breach of trust, or moral turpitude.

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Fuller applied for a surety bail bond license on May 17, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Fuller answered "No" to the question on the application: "Have you ever been convicted, or are you currently charged with, committing a crime, whether or not adjudication was withheld?"; and

**WHEREAS**, on or about January 19, 2011 Mr. Fuller was found guilty on one count of Misdemeanor Assault on a Female (/Wilson County NC, File # 11CR 050283); and

**WHEREAS**, on or about January 19, 2011, Mr. Fuller was found guilty on one count of Misdemeanor Injury to Personal Property (Wilson County NC, File # 11CR 050283); and

**WHEREAS**, on or about January 19, 2011, Mr. Fuller was found guilty on one count of Misdemeanor Injury to Real Property (Wilson County, NC File # 11CR 050283); and

**WHEREAS**, violations of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 58-71-80 (a) (3) and (a) (6) are grounds for denying Mr. Fuller's application for licensure; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department denied Mr. Fuller's application on June 27, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Fuller agreed on September 6, 2018 in principle to execute a Voluntary Settlement Agreement and pay a fine in the amount of \$500.00 as a condition to being licensed as a surety bail bondsman; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the promises and agreements set out herein, the Department and Mr. Fuller hereby agree to the following:

1. Immediately upon his signing of this document, Mr. Fuller shall pay a civil penalty of \$500.00 to the Department. The form of payment shall be in the form of a certified check, cashier's check or money order. The check or money order for the payment of this civil penalty shall be payable to the "North Carolina Department of Insurance." Mr. Fuller shall send the civil penalty by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the Department simultaneously with the return of this Agreement, signed by Mr. Fuller. The civil penalty and the signed Agreement must be received by the Department no later than **November 14, 2018**. The civil penalty shall be subject to disbursement in accordance with the provisions of Article IX, Section 7 of the North Carolina Constitution for the benefit of the public schools.
2. The Department has reconsidered its denial of Mr. Fuller's application for licensure as a surety bail bondsman and will issue Mr. Fuller a surety bondsman's license upon receipt of Mr. Fuller's execution of this Voluntary Settlement Agreement and return to the Department accompanied with payment of the civil penalty set forth above in the amount of \$500.00; and
3. Mr. Fuller shall obey all laws and regulations applicable to all licenses issued to



him.

4. Mr. Fuller enters into this Agreement freely and voluntarily and with knowledge of his right to have an administrative hearing on this matter. Mr. Fuller understands that he may consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Agreement.
5. This Agreement does not in any way affect the Department's disciplinary power in any future follow-up examinations of Mr. Fuller, or in any other cases or complaints involving Mr. Fuller.
6. The parties to this Agreement agree that this Agreement shall have the full force and effect of an Order of the Commissioner. Mr. Fuller understands that N. C. Gen. Stat. § 58-71-80(a)(7) provides that a surety bondsman's license may be revoked for violating an Order of the Commissioner.
7. This Voluntary Settlement Agreement, when finalized, will be a public record and is not confidential. All licenses issued by the Department to the licensee shall reflect that Regulatory Action has been taken against the licensee following the execution of this Agreement. The Department is free to disclose the contents of this Agreement to third parties upon request or pursuant to any law or policy providing for such disclosure. The Department routinely provides copies of voluntary settlement agreements to all companies that have appointed the licensee.
8. This Settlement Agreement shall become effective when signed by Mr. Fuller and the Department.
