Dear Mr. Roventini,

In response to your letter requesting an explanation of MetLife's termination; please be aware that I was employed with a broker dealer, Gunn Allen Financial in New York who had a selling agreement with MetLife.

I resigned from my employment from Gunn Allen Financial in January 2009 voluntarily. MetLife did not terminate me as I stopped employment with the broker dealer that had a selling agreement with them and not being affiliated with the broker dealer I was not eligible to do business with MetLife.

In 2004 I was employed as a broker with S.W.Bach&Co., in New York. I have been a broker for over twenty years, and never had a problem. S.W.Bach was a brokerage with many problems that I was not aware of. I left that firm May 2006 voluntarily with no complaints or claims.

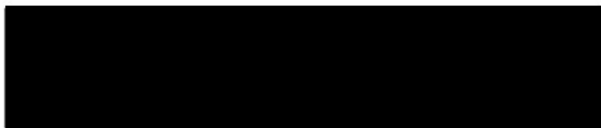
S.W.Bach was audited by the NASD after I left. S.W.Bach was in such disarray and had no supervision, that there was no one to answer any questions relating to applications, which I was advised were the proper forms. Again there were no complaints, claims or losses. Everything that I submitted was approved by SW Bach compliance officers and the insurance carriers. SW Bach went bankrupt and Finra decided to suspend me for one year as there was no one at SW Bach to take responsibility for any administrative error.

I am presently unemployed and if you wish to cancel my North Carolina license please do.
